### Latest River and Catch Report

**Week ending 5<sup>th</sup> July:**

#### FISHNITH REPORT

##### Prospects

With light showers and heavy rain forecast for this week (BBC Local Weather), river levels are set to rise again. This should continue to flush out the river and move the fresh fish along, which can only be good news for fishermen. Plenty fish are being seen up and down the river so there is no excuse not to get out there and get catching. Good luck!

##### Last week

Another rise in River levels encouraged anglers out last week giving a good return of 14 Salmon and 18 Sea Trout between Monday and Wednesday with at least another 3 Salmon and 5 Sea Trout reported during the rest of the week.

One gentleman had a 15lb Salmon and 8 Sea Trout in two days! 2 Salmon were caught on DGAA Cairn water (10lb and 8lb), 2 at Dalswinton (10lb and 5#lb), 1 at Barjarg (8#lb), 1 at Drumlanrig and 2 at Upper Nithsdale (8lb each) among others.

Among the Sea Trout landed were 3 at DGAA Cairn Water (1# each), 3 at Dalswinton (4lb, 2#lb and 2lb), 2 at Drumlanrig (2#lb and 4#lb) and 2 at Upper Nithsdale (2#lb each).

Plenty Salmon have been seen in the middle beats on the River though several caught had sea lice. River levels are now dropping again but not yet back to summer levels - hopefully the showers forecast in the coming weeks will maintain the height to encourage the fish to keep running. A Grilse was caught on Friday at Dalswinton - one of the first reported.
